Greetings to all,



As spring is springing and the birds are chirping, it is time to start planning for the 2024 IHCC chapter 15 show in Le Sueur. I have been tasked with planning the layout for the main feature building. With this show being the 100th anniversary celebration of Farmall, we are trying to get a chronological display of the run through the Farmall years. We will have a Regular and a current Farmall in the center of the building. Arnolds of Mankato has already agreed to get us the current tractor for the display.

What we are looking for from the members. We have room for approximately 18 tractors in the main building. We would like to see examples for every series of the Farmall run. F series to the 88 series. I have put together a basic idea of what would fit the intent of the display. We are thinking of a small and large tractor from each series. Here is the basic idea. F12/14 and a F20/30. A C or Super C and an M. We would also add in a SMTA being that it is also the 70th anniversary of that tractor this year. Then a 100/200 with a 300/400. followed by 130/230 and a 350/450. I think you can see the idea here. When we get to the larger/newer models (56, 66, 86, 88) it would just be one of each.



We know that a lot of our members have tractors that they would love to have in the main building. We do have a few guidelines that we need to put in place. We would ask that any tractors be in "show worthy" condition. Also, for safety and ease of set up, any tractors that are displayed in the main building will be in the building for the duration of the show, not taken out for the parade or tractor pull.

Anyone that would like to have their tractor in the main building is asked to send a picture and a description to me at my email listed below. We are not trying to have a tractor judging contest, or pick out any one person. We just want the best representation of the Farmall history that we can come up with!

The club has 304 members as of April 18, 2024.


